Reporting to the Artistic Director, this position provides hip hop instruction and choreography to individuals and groups in a manner consistent with the mission, vision, goals, and objectives of The Heart. The position will also participate in various student performances and perform other related duties.

Main Responsibilities:

- Prepare, develop and teach weekly hip hop classes that are challenging and engaging for students
- Ensure the development of required skills for dancers in each class, based on age and level
- Prepare students for specific performances and teach age and level-appropriate choreography to be presented at various shows throughout the year under supervision of the Director
- Participate in performances by attending student performances and certain rehearsals throughout the year, such as the technical and dress rehearsals at the Yukon Arts Centre (YAC) in preparation for the January Production and Art from the Heart in May/June in
- Attend demonstrations, auditions and lectures as required
- Participate in audition selection processes as required
- Communicate effectively by reporting ideas, problems and concerns about classes directly to the Artistic Director
